The House will meet at 10:00 a.m. for legislative business and recess immediately. The House will reconvene at approximately 11:00 a.m. for the purpose of receiving, in a joint meeting with the Senate, the Honorable Julia Gillard, Prime Minister of Australia.

Following the address, the House will continue with legislative business, starting with one minute speeches. There will be no Morning Hour.

It allows any Member to offer an amendment, provided that they have submitted their amendment and it is printed in the Congressional record (the deadline to submit is the evening of March 9). Pro forma amendments are allowed under the Rule, as well as one motion to recommit with instructions.**
