Ordering the Previous Question to deny the Polis Amendment on [H.Res. 236](#) - Would allow for Mr. Lipinski's bill, [H.R. 1366](#) – National Manufacturing Strategy Act of 2011, to be considered. H.R. 1366 would call on the President to put forward a manufacturing strategy every four years to ensure that American manufacturers can grow and compete in the global economy – which many other nations already do. **(234 - 185)**

[H.R. 1213](#) - Repeal mandatory funding provided to States in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to establish American Health Benefit Exchanges (Rep. Upton – Energy and Commerce) **(238 – 183)**
