Motion to Go to Conference on [H.R. 4173](#) – Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2009 (Rep. Frank – Financial Services)

Bills Adopted Under Suspension of the Rules (7):

- 1) [H.R. 5026](#) - GRID Act (Rep. Markey (MA) - Energy and Commerce)
- 2) [H.Res. 1330](#) - Recognizing June 8, 2010, as World Ocean Day (Rep. Farr - Oversight and Government Reform)
- 3) [H.R. 5278](#) - To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 405 West Second Street in Dixon, Illinois, as the "President Ronald W. Reagan Post Office Building" (Rep. Foster - Oversight and Government Reform)
- 4) [H.R. 5133](#) - To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 331 1st Street in Carlstadt, New Jersey, as the "Staff Sergeant Frank T. Carvill and Lance Corporal Michael A. Schwarz Post Office Building" (Rep. Rothman - Oversight and Government Reform)
