**TOMORROW'S OUTLOOK**

The GOP Leadership has announced the following schedule: on Wednesday, the House will meet at 10:00 a.m. for legislative business and recess immediately. The House then will re-convene at 10:45 a.m. to receive His Excellency Viktor Yushchenko, President of the Ukraine, in a Joint Meeting of Congress. In addition, the House is expected to consider five bills under Suspension of the Rules and may also consider: **S. 256 - Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005** (*Sen. Grassley - Judiciary*) (*Subject to a Rule*).
