Considered and Passed:

Ordering the Previous Question to deny the Bishop (NY) Amendment on [H.Res. 150](#) – would allow for [H.R. 964](#) – The Federal Price Gouging Prevention Act of 2011 to be considered. H.R. 964 makes it unlawful, during a period proclaimed by the President as an energy emergency, to sell gasoline at a price that is unconscionably excessive or indicates the seller is taking unfair advantage of the circumstances of an emergency to increase prices unreasonably. **(235 - 186)**
