## FLOOR SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE

The House will meet at 2:00 p.m. for legislative business. At the conclusion of "One-Minute" speeches the House will recess until 4:00 p.m. Debate on Suspension bills will begin at 4:00 p.m. **Votes are postponed until 6:30 p.m. Last vote expected: 7:00 p.m.**

### Suspensions (2 bills):

The House is scheduled to consider 2 Suspension bills. Suspension bills are debatable for **40 minutes each**, may not be amended, and require two-thirds majority for passage.

- 1) **H.Res. 25** - Supporting efforts to promote greater awareness of the need for youth mentors and increased involvement with youth through mentoring.
- 2) **H.Res. 26** - Honoring the contributions of Catholic schools.
