Suspensions (3 bills):

- 1) H.Con.Res. 166** - Expressing the sense of Congress in support of Buckle Up America Week (*Vitter - T&I*).
- 2) H.R. 1018** - To designate the building located at 1 Federal Plaza in New York, New York, as the "James L. Watson United States Court of International Trade Building" (*Rangel - T&I*).
- 3) H.Con.Res. 147** - Commemorating the 20th Anniversary of the Orphan Drug Act and the National Organization for Rare Disorders (*Foley - Energy & Commerce*).
